

SD Department of Health – WIC Program

WIC is a special supplemental nutrition program for eligible women, infants and children. It is funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. It is administered by the South Dakota Department of Health. WIC’s goal is to promote and maintain the health and well-being of nutritionally at-risk women, infants and young children. WIC is available in most counties in the state, or covered by surrounding county. WIC is an equal opportunity program. WIC provides nutrition education and counseling, breast-feeding support, referrals, and resources.

WIC serves eligible:

- Women and teens who are pregnant, breast-feeding up to 12 months after delivery, or have had a baby in the last six months
- Infants
- Children up to age five

To be eligible, an applicant must:

- Meet residency guidelines (South Dakota resident)
- Have a nutrition or health risk
- Meet income guidelines
