

## SD Department of Health – WIC Program

### What is WIC?

- WIC means women, infants, and children.
- WIC is a supplemental nutrition program.
- WIC is funded by the United States Department of Agriculture.
- WIC provides families with benefits to purchase foods like milk, eggs, and cereal at authorized grocery stores.
- WIC provides breastfeeding support.
- WIC can refer you to other services.

### Who can get WIC?

- Women who are pregnant or have been pregnant in the last six months or are breastfeeding a baby under age one
- Infants up to age one
- Children up to age five

### Applicants must:

- Be a South Dakota resident
- Complete a Nutritional Assessment
- Qualify based on income
  - Women, infants, and children who meet WIC criteria and are on TANF, SNAP (Food Stamps), or an approved aid category for Medicaid automatically meet income guidelines.
